

CSSS Beijing 2008 Projects

Project Guidelines

- Groups must contain 3–6 people.
- Groups must be interdisciplinary.
- Groups should consist of both Chinese and foreigners.
- The project does not necessarily need to be original, publishable research.
- Make use of the expertise of the faculty and fellow students.
- You are encouraged to take risks and try out new, creative ideas.

Timeline

1. **Week of June 30–July 4.** Meet other students, begin discussing project ideas and topics.
2. **Noon on Tuesday 8 July.** Groups must be set by this date, and all students must be in one and only one group. One person from each group should email Richard and Dave telling us who is in the group and your group's tentative topic.
3. **Week of July 7–11.** Meet with your group, begin refining project topic. All groups should meet with Dave Feldman or another faculty member during this week.
4. **Week of July 14–18.** Continue to work on projects. Meet with faculty as desired.
5. **5:00 PM, Monday 21 July.** Deadline for submitting materials for poster session.
6. **Wednesday 24 July.** Deadline to submit abstract for poster or presentation. Please email the abstract to Richard or Dave.
7. **July 24 and 25.** Research group presentations.
8. **Friday 25 July.** Poster session and closing banquet.
9. **Monday 18 August.** Deadline for submitting final papers. Papers should be emailed to Lee Goodwin at summerschool@santafe.edu.
